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GUIDELINES FOR PAPER SUBMISSION

The full original paper along with the abstract should be organized in the following format-

- Abstract, Keywords, Introduction, Aims/Objectives, Hypotheses (if any), Method, Results and Discussion, Conclusion, Acknowledgement (if any). APA 7th edition, 2020 format is to be followed for References.
- Case studies, best practices and success stories can also be submitted in the form of articles.
- The full paper should be within 2500 to 3000 words excluding references and abstract, typed in MS Word with font type Times New Roman, 12 font size, line spacing of 1.5 with left alignment. The cover page should reflect title of the paper, name of author(s), designation, institutional affiliation and address, e-mail ID and contact number of the corresponding author. The cover page need to specify the theme as well as the mode of presentations.
- The abstract should be of 250-300 words, which reflects objectives, method, major findings, results and major implications.
- **Plagiarism Alert:** The paper should be free of plagiarism. A self-declaration regarding the original ity of the paper is to be attached.
